


Contacting Elected Officials

Knowing how to contact your elected officials is critical for any advocacy objectives you may have. To find your elected officials, visit [this](#) site.



→ Legislators By Phone

A legislator's office phone number can be found in their official bios on the [House](#) and [Senate](#) websites. Lawmakers and office staff monitor these lines.



→ Legislators By Email

A legislator's email address follows a formulaic system.

For Representatives, the format is rep##@ohiohouse.gov. The ## is the two-digit district code they represent, so the Representative from Ohio House District 1's email is rep01@ohiohouse.gov.



For Senators, the format is lastname@ohiosenate.gov so the email address for a Senator with the last name America is america@ohiosenate.gov

→ Legislators By Letter

A legislator's physical mail address can be found in their official bios on the House and Senate websites. Legislators' offices are in the Statehouse or the Vern Riffe building.
